CHOLERA

Cholera is a water borne disease which has claimed many peoples lives. When water gets into contact with faecal matter, under the ground or when piped water is exposed to sewage or drainage systems, it gets contaminated.

To prevent spread and contracting cholera, requires one to practice good health habits. Boil all drinking water or use water purifiers to ensure safety of your water. Cook food properly, wash vegetables or fruits before eating them raw.

Always cover your food and water. Avoid buying food from roadside vendors.

Wash hands with soap before handling food, after visiting a toilet or latrine. Finally visit a health facility immediately you sense symptoms like stomach-ache and diarrhea.
