Please make sure that you cross-check spellings of names since the list is just scanned and entered into the system for processing results to generate the mark sheet. ***The committee shall not prepare mark sheets for schools that fail to submit the typed candidates' list following the format above.***

The generated mark sheet will be sent with confidential instructions.

Each school will be required to photocopy the sent list and have the candidates sign for attendance on that list for each paper done and insert it into the answer scripts parcel.

This signed list will be attached to the mark sheet for that particular paper, which will help to ensure that all candidates who sat the paper get their results mark sheeted.

N.B: Schools can register either physically at WAKISSHA Resource Centre OR register online by scanning pdf format of all the above fully filled registration documents (summary of entries, weekly packing forms and candidates list) stamped on each page and the fully paid deposit slip for all mock fees in (iv) below and send them as attachments by WHATSAPP to 0783 175 297. Please follow up that you receive confirmation of receipt of the sent documents, done by sending the copy of receipt for the payment made and reference number.

Note: Each candidate at either level needs approximately **27 booklets** for the whole examinations season. We encourage use of these booklets for uniformity and practice for the final examinations. (in summary each packet is used by **four candidates**).

Schools intending to register additional candidates after the first submission should arrange and do ONLY ONE additional submission. Multiple additional will not be accepted and no additional will be accepted after 14th July 2026.

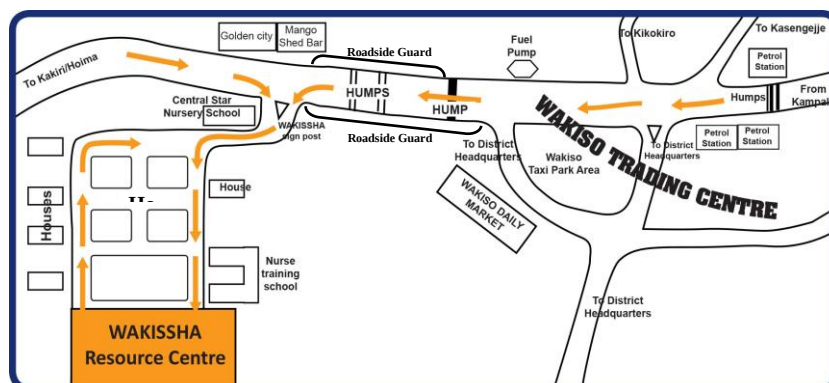
Schools that register after the date for confidential dispatch will have to pick them from the resource centre or wait to receive them with week one papers.
